### Footnotes

FAST ISTINTAJ five wide into the first turn, moved up between rivals to share the lead on the backstretch, drew clear just off the inside on the second bend, took the rail into the stretch, lengthened her lead, began to tire inside the last furlong, was put to a drive inside the last sixteenth and held on. FREEZE EM ECHO forwardly placed between horses, was three wide taking the second bend, all out through the stretch, closed well but was too late. REACH FOR IT settled, lost ground five wide through the first turn, picked up her pace from outside on the backstretch, came into the contention four wide on the second bend, fanned out further entering the lane and battled to keep third as she made up ground on the top pair the final eighth. LISA'S PRIDE boxed in between horses on the backstretch, was three wide on the second turn, swung out widest leaving that bend, closed strongly but also came up short. SOARING DEVON advanced from outside on the backstretch, was three then four wide taking the second bend and only made up minor ground the final furlong. BE RHYTHMIC bumped and forced in at the break, advanced from inside on the first turn, came out a bit to be between rivals on the backstretch, was just off the inside through the second bend and lacked the extra needed for the drive. PRECIOUS BAY QUEEN bumped, forced in and squeezed briefly at the start, was an early factor from inside, steadied while boxed in behind the fading LA SOBRINA through the early turn, altered out some nearing the quarter pole, fanned to path three for the stretch run and had no rally. LA SOBRINA bore inward at the break, bumping solidly with PRECIOUS BAY QUEEN, quickly recovered to gain the lead just off the inside, was challenged from outside on the backstretch, quit along the rail on the second bend, distanced herself through the lane and was walked off.
