BEAU WIZER chased the early leader racing off the inside, sustained a bid three wide to gain a short lead at the eighth pole and finished gamely to hold sway. IT'S TERA was within striking distance early six wide, drifted in three wide to place a bid, closed well late and missed. CAPITOL GUY prompted the early pace three wide between rivals, angled in through the stretch and finished well. SPARTAN WARRIOR was off slow early, went three wide into the stretch, angled out near the three sixteenths, then altered in at the sixteenth pole, was gaining late but lacked room nearing the wire. TEXAS SILVER raced mid pack saving ground, sustained a brief bid then went evenly late. SAPELLO CANTADOR was forwardly placed early four wide and lacked a closing effort late. RUSSIAN LANE set the early pace saving ground, held to nearing the eighth pole then faltered. DODSON was void of early speed, went eight wide and was not a factor. SILENT SUNDAY broke slowly at the break, went four wide, drifted out wide late and failed to menace.
