Footnotes

MT. FRANKLIN was outrun early five wide, gained steadily down the backstretch into the second turn, then edged clear nearing the eighth pole and was best late. SUPER SAPELLO was off slow early, closed the gap four wide, shifted out between foes in mid stretch and closed well. MAX BEAN was within striking distance early racing off the inside, angled out five wide near the quarter pole and finished willingly late. OUTFOCHO was forwardly placed early four wide and placed a mild bid late. HIGH RIDGE RUNNER chased the early leader and was finished early. CHROME BOY set the early pace saving ground and came up empty in the stretch. FLOMOT raced mid pack four wide and lacked a late effort. DEPOT RED was close in the early going, went three wide and faded in the stretch. FLIPSON showed little in a dull effort. SOARING N X S was wide into the first turn then angled in down the backstretch and

lacked a closing bid. SHINNY SEASON failed to threaten. CRAFTY SHEIK retreated steadily.
