PIERRE BEAR set the early pace racing off the rail, drew clear down the backstretch, opened up in the second turn and held safe to be much the best. LEGAL CITIZEN was unhurried early, went four wide to rally, showed some effort late to gain the place but was no match for the winner. MILLER'S TIME raced in the second flight saving ground began to close the gap placing a bid in the second turn but was outfinished for the place in the final yards. TAPFORTEXAS was off slow early saving ground, sustained a steady effort to mid stretch then went evenly. AIRTIGHT was void of early speed saving ground, angled out five wide and placed a mild bid. C'EM BLAZIN was outrun early, raced wide and lacked a rally. GETSETGETREADYGO raced mid pack, went six wide at the quarter pole then drifted out in the stretch. MAKING PAPA PROUD was hard to rate into the first turn, forced the pace, was finished after a half and retreated.
