ON DOWN THE ROAD was within striking distance early, went four wide to place a bid near the three sixteenths, responded well in deep stretch and surged clear. GOTTA MOVE prompted the early pace from the outside, vied to gain a short lead, was challenged in deep stretch and failed to last. DASH TA FAME raced mid pack, went five wide closing the gap, gained the show then went evenly late. DESERT DUDE was unhurried early, swung out five wide to place a brief bid then flattened. GHOSTLY FLY was outrun early saving ground, angled out four wide and placed a mild effort. DIESEL INJUN was off slow early, went four wide and was not a threat. V. A. S. SIDEKICK was forwardly placed along the inside then faded steadily. BANGOR showed some brief speed along the rail and was used up early. BIG TIME PLAYER raced wide, was taken up in the second turn and vanned off.
