Footnotes

RUNNIN RED shared the lead between horses, roused three wide on the second bend, moved clear upper stretch then maintained control under steady urging. CIMPLY DONE was kept close between rivals, squeezed through two wide into the second turn and gained a narrow advantage inside RUNNIN RED, could not stay with that one into the lane, angled outside RUNNIN RED upper stretch, drifted out with a furlong left, was corrected but could only hold second late. MAGNIFICENT STORM hesitated at the break, advanced from outside on the backstretch, took the second bend four wide, found best stride too late but caught EXCESSIVE VALU for third. EXCESSIVE VALU was prominent from outside, three wide with a quarter mile left, angled in some for the stretch run and lacked the needed bid. HIGH RIDGE RUNNER set or forced the pace inside to the second bend then did not have enough left the last quarter mile. STARLIGHT MESA settled inside, angled out on the second turn, came five wide into the lane and advanced without threatening. DIAMONDS FOR V F bobbled at the break, stayed well off the inside throughout and failed to menace. BLANTONS raced in contention toward the outside to the second bend then gave way. SURPRISINGLY GONE was an early factor just off the inside, was in tight quarters two wide on the second turn then faltered the last quarter.
