CHUCHULUCO pressed the early pace four wide, placed a bid between foes near the quarter pole, edged clear into the stretch and widened late. RIG'S RUNNER forced the early pace three wide, vied in the stretch, battled for the place and just held. HUNTIN THE TRASH was unhurried early, rallied from between rivals into the stretch and was gaining. TRAIN RIDER BLUES was allowed to settle early racing along the inside, showed some effort late drifting out in the stretch. D E HAPPY HOUR was within striking distance early while saving ground then weakened in the lane. HEZA RARE BULL broke slowly at the start and showed some interest late along the inside. QUINTON'S PLACE was outrun early four wide and lacked a late response. S D S GOLDEN BOY was close in the early going, went six wide at the three sixteenth and lacked a rally. UNBRIDLED EGO was forwardly placed early saving ground then faded steadily. SIDE CAR was quickly into stride to set the early angling in to save some ground and was finished after half. HALF VOLLEY failed to menace.
