### Footnotes

OROGRANDE SPECIAL rated from inside early, gradually altered out midway on the backstretch, bumped with GHOSTLY FLY with a half mile to go, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, had the lead leaving that bend, was clearly inside the final furlong, under a steady drive, drifted out a bit inside the last sixteenth but held sway. SOME KIND OF LUCK broke a bit slowly and outward, leaned on TRISTANS SLEW briefly, was settled off the inside, angled out after straightening on the backstretch, altered in when his path was taken nearing the nine-sixteenths marker, in path four entering the second turn, lost further ground fanning to the middle of the track into the lane, closed well but was too late. GHOSTLY FLY prominent between horses, was bumped at the half mile pole, in tight between rivals into the second turn, make up ground four wide on that bend and found best stride too late the last eighth. BOOGER BOO raced in contention three wide on the backstretch, gradually angled in on the second turn, progressed along the rail in the lane, was steadied lacking room with a sixteenth to go and got through seventy yards out. INIQUITOUS KID advanced just off the inside on the backstretch, took the

rail into the second bend, came off the inside some for the stretch run, gradually made up ground inside the final furlong and was forced out at the seventy yard pole. MROBNOXIOUS soon had the advantage between rivals, set a pressured pace just off the inside, lost the lead leaving the second turn, moved to the rail upper stretch, slowly wore down and drifted out one path under a left whip with seventy yards left. TRISTANS SLEW crowded at the break, was blocked while toward the outside on the backstretch, angled in some entering the second bend, slowly progressed three wide and was also forced out deep stretch. CLARA'S TIZZYCAT waited for room behind a wall of horses on the backstretch, gained a clear path four wide on the second turn, fanned out some entering the lane, altered outside NEW MEXICO KID upper stretch but had no late bid. NEW MEXICO KID bumped with CANSAN CAKEWALK at the start, advanced from outside, lost ground five wide through the second turn and flattened out for the drive. ANNIE'S BOY displayed early speed just outside MROBNOXIOUS, could not keep up into the second turn, faded just off the inside leaving the quarter pole, was steadied in traffic at the head of the lane and continued to give way. CANSAN CAKEWALK bumped at the break, was a contender between horses to the second turn but tired from path three after that. MR. BAND TIME well placed inside, gave way along the rail on the second turn.
