Footnotes

BUCKSTER stalked from between horses, began his bid three wide on the turn, took over nearing the sixteenth marker and gradually opened up under urging. DIXIELAND CHIME pressed from inside, angled out three wide for room on the turn, was just off the inside entering the lane, had a slight advantage midstretch, was no match for BUCKSTER late but lasted for the place. CHACO LATTE forwardly placed between horses, was just off the inside on the bend, angled out behind BUCKSTER inside the final furlong and pulled clear for third in the waning yards. RED RULLAH contested the pace from outside, was two wide taking the turn, gained the rail upper stretch and slowly wore down inside the final furlong. AMOROSO saved ground on the bend, was

steadied behind traffic at the head of the lane, altered out to path six and gradually made up ground. TONY THE CAT was a contender between horses on the backstretch, began to fade while three then four wide taking the turn and lacked a significant stretch response. RADCLIFFE MAN forwardly placed from outside, swung five wide for the drive and did not have enough left. DIXIE FILM jostled with YVETT'S MAAR shortly after the break, was wide through the bend and had no stretch bid. YVETT'S MAAR angled out some shortly after the start, jostled for twenty yards, was steadied along the rail when crowded midway on the backstretch, two and three wide taking the turn and empty for the drive. DUKE IT OUT LUKE void of speed, was widest through the bend and had little through the lane. ONE BELL OF A BULL was angled out early trying to keep a clear path, came four wide into the stretch and was also empty. UNCLE JACK G displayed speed between horses, took the rail on the turn then faltered for the drive.
