**Footnotes**

WINSOME NETTE kept close toward the outside, commenced her bid three wide leaving the second turn, gained a slight advantage inside the eighth pole, dug in and held off ANGLE'S LUCK. ANGLE'S LUCK rated just off the early speed from inside, made her move along the rail into the stretch, battled to the wire, did not have enough late but was clearly second best. LA BENDIGA jostled between horses at the break, was settled outside, angled in on the second turn, came out for a clear path upper stretch, altered inside RETREAT HOME inside the last furlong and took over third. RETREAT HOME contested the pace between rivals, moved clear and stayed just off the inside on the second bend, was challenged from both sides in the lane, began to wear down, veered out after entering the last eighth and gradually yielded. R PERKS an early factor, was two wide leaving the second turn, altered out five wide for a clear path upper stretch but had no late bid. BACK SEAT MOVES bumped with LA BENDIGA at the break, raced wide throughout and failed to menace. YEA IM A REDHEAD jostled with LATIN HEAT at the start, showed no speed from outside, came to the rail for the stretch run and had no rally. LATIN HEAT jostled between rivals and shuffled back at the start, was also void of speed, stayed off the inside through the second turn and was empty for the drive. C T CHOCOLATE CHIP well back, saved ground taking the second turn and had little left the last quarter mile. SAINT CLAIRE WHO displayed early speed three wide, gave way between rivals into the second turn, was eased the last furlong and walked off.
