Footnotes

VICTORIOUS VEE contested the pace between horses, two wide on the second turn, battled in the lane then edged ahead under steady handling in the late going. BAREFOOT BABY moved up along the rail to vie for the lead on the backstretch, fought gamely through the stretch but did not have enough left. TACTICAL rated between rivals the first half mile, progressed along the rail on the second bend, fanned three wide for the stretch run, took over third and could only just hold her position late. PUMPED altered out for room on the first turn, gradually made up ground from outside, angled in two wide on the second turn then found best stride too late the last eighth. PAULISTANNA soon had the lead, set the pace from path three or four, could not keep up on the second turn, fanned out to path five into the stretch and gradually faded. WILDCAT GIRL was well placed just off the rail on the backstretch but faded from inside the last five-sixteenths. CHAMPAGNE LASS away somewhat slowly, rushed up, drifted out into the first bend, was soon under control, progressed outside to threaten on the backstretch but gave way on the second turn. DAME FONTEYN displayed early speed four wide but faded three wide on the second turn.
