CATCH THE BEAN was unhurried early, vied nearing the quarter pole five wide, wore down his foes through the stretch and was best late. OUR CHOICE was outrun early, moved up quickly on the rail in the second turn, gained a short lead nearing the eighth pole, was challenged in deep stretch, battled gamely then gave way grudgingly. BRAX tracked the early leaders saving ground, shuffled back into the second turn, angled out three wide and came back for the show. SHUG'S STORM CAT set the early pace drawing clear, held the advantage into the stretch along the inside, then drifted out nearing the three sixteenth and weakened. ROSA'S CATENA prompted the early pace three wide then came up empty in the stretch. SILVER MATTHAIS failed to menace racing off the inside. STARLIGHT MESA trailed the field saving ground, angled four wide and lacked a bid.
