Footnotes

RED RANCH ROAD shared the lead from between rivals, three wide on the turn, angled in two wide at the top of the lane, drifted out some after entering the final furlong, was clear with a sixteenth to go and held sway under steady handling. SOARING QUOTES bumped and forced into ZSA CAT at the break, moved up quickly to press the early speed, waited for room two wide on the turn, got through four wide leaving the bend and slowly closed the gap. SINAMON N NUTMEG bumped hard from the rear shortly after the start, was boxed in behind the pacesetters, got through three wide into the stretch, had every chance between rivals but hung in the late going. ELEGANT JUDGE showed first, was forwardly placed outside, four and five wide through the bend and could only make up a small amount of ground the final furlong. FIRE E BEAN was never far back while between horses, just off the inside on the turn, was blocked and looking for room upper stretch, gained an opening two wide inside the eighth pole then gradually made up ground. IT'STIMEFORAMILLER away somewhat slowly, stumbled just out of the gate, was taken outside, lost ground four to six wide through the turn, had a striking position midstretch but leveled off instead. SANDIA STARDUST broke inward, contested the pace between rivals, two wide on the turn, moved to the rail at the head of the lane and gradually wore down. WILLIE JONES rated from inside, fanned out to path three entering the stretch, was blocked with a furlong to go, altered out to

the middle of the track inside the furlong marker and steadily closed the gap. STORMY'S BOY forced in at the break, bumped SOARING QUOTES, was hustled along to vie for the lead inside, could not keep up leaving the turn, gradually backed up, was steadied behind SANDIA STARDUST deep stretch and altered out. ZSA CAT bumped first with SOARING QUOTES then SINAMON N NUTMEG, advanced between horses, three to five wide through the bend, found himself behind ELEGANT JUDGE upper stretch, altered out seven wide near the eighth pole and had no late bid. STOCK GURU was soon far back and inside, saved ground and showed little.
