Footnotes

BIG JOHN BEAN was allowed to settle early, sustained a bid between rivals, split foes nearing the five sixteenths, gained the advantage at the eighth pole and drew clear. MAX BEAN forced the early pace from the outside, vied nearing the quarter pole to gain a short lead into the stretch, was challenged late and flattened nearing the wire. GHOST SMASHER was forwardly placed early racing off the rail, rallied into the second turn splitting foes, moved up to contend with the pacesetter at the quarter then came up empty in the stretch but held the show. ANNIE'S BOY raced mid pack early, shuffled back down the backstretch, angled out late and lacked a gain. SLICKUNO dropped back early saving ground and improved his position in the stretch. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was off slow early, went five wide down the backstretch, made a move mid way then faded. GLENWOOD AUGGIE was outrun racing seven wide down the backstretch and failed to menace. KING'S JOURNEY showed some early speed along the inside and was finished after a half.
