DRY SUMMER tracked the early leaders three wide, rallied nearing the five sixteenths, dueled into the stretch then surged clear. STORMDRIVER set the early pace saving ground, dueled in the turn, battled into the stretch then yielded in the late going. SHOW SOME MAGIC pressed the early pace from the outside, dueled between foes in the stretch then weakened. TWO SCOTCH BLUES was void of early speed racing off the rail and improved his position in the stretch. JUAN'S CORAZONSITO was unhurried early and lacked a late response. LEWISTON was never far back early, went four wide and weakened. WNRWNRWINEFORDNNER was outrun early racing wide, angled in to saved some ground and was eased to the wire. THE FINAL TIME WAS HAND TIMED.
