Footnotes

JUST ALITTLE BEAD contested the pace from paths two or three while between horses, moved ahead leaving the second turn, drifted out under a left whip at the head of the lane, was corrected, floated out again under left-handed pressure midstretch, was again straightened, lugged in under a right whip near the sixteenth pole and maintained control. DANNY'S GHOST bumped with MOSTLY DUST at the start, boxed in behind the early speed on the backstretch, was two wide into the second bend, moved inside midway on that turn, came off the rail some with a quarter mile left, lost his path upper stretch, was clear at the eighth pole, angled in some as JUST ALITTLE BEAD came in nearing the sixteenth marker, was checked briefly at that pole, altered out and bumped with DR WILDCARD in the waning yards. DR WILDCARD was prominent three or four wide from the early going, in path four entering the stretch, fought for second, lugged in some after entering the final sixteenth and bumped with DANNY'S GHOST. DOUBLE RECESS in contention between horses, improved position just off the inside on the second turn, swung out behind DR WILDCARD into the lane, closed the gap upper stretch then had to alter his path twice the last sixteenth. LOUIE'S BROTHER forwardly placed outside, progressed four wide on the second bend, fanned outside DR WILDCARD into the stretch, had every chance through the lane but hung in the late going. ONE FINE JEWEL broke outward, trailed, advanced five wide through the second turn and gradually improved position the last quarter mile without threatening. SLEWS GLORY void of speed from inside, fanned to path three for the stretch run and passed some tired ones. KING DEXTER failed to menace in a wide trip. MOSTLY DUST bumped with DANNY'S GHOST at the start, was steadied repeatedly while boxed in behind the pacesetters on the first turn, split horses two wide into the second bend, took a narrow lead, moved to the rail near the quarter pole, lost the advantage soon after and flattened out in the lane. CASE FILE broke on top, duelled for the lead from inside but gave way along the rail on the second bend.
