Footnotes

CHARMING MOVES broke outward, bumping ALL THE HARD WAYS, was rated between horses, had the rail on the bend, altered out five wide upper stretch, squeezed through between horses and got up in time. ALL THE HARD WAYS bumped at the break, helped prompt the pace from between rivals, came three wide into the lane, moved ahead but was outfinished in the waning yards. GAVITA advanced from inside, angled out some on the bend, was three wide entering the stretch, altered out some near the eighth pole, could not make up much ground in the late going but moved ahead for third. DIRTY SHAME prominent from the beginning, waited for room from inside on the turn, got through along the rail at the head of the lane, threatened but could not sustain her bid the final sixteenth. PULPIT ACCOUNT raced in contention between horses, advanced three wide on the turn, fanned out further for the stretch run and ran evenly the last eighth. GO TO GOLD quickly took the lead, showed the way between rivals, had the rail on the bend, floated out some into the stretch and slowly wore down. LATENITE FINALE chased while toward the outside, was widest through the turn, improved position upper stretch but could not close the gap. SOUR GIRL pressed from outside, was three wide into the turn, swung out to path six for the stretch run and gradually faded. VERY SHINEY in tight briefly at the start, was an early factor between rivals, also three wide entering the bend, lost ground fanning outside SOUR GIRL for the drive and continued to yield. SCHARLYN soon faded, gradually angled in, was just off the rail entering the lane and only passed a couple more tired. HOWHI ISTHEWATER also in tight briefly at the break, was blocked and gradually angled out trying to gain a clear path on the backstretch, swung out behind LATENITE FINALE for the stretch run and had little to offer. ARE YOU CRAZY in contention early, faded just off the inside leaving the bend.
