Footnotes

GONE PACK N gradually progressed from inside, came off the rail upper stretch, split rivals under a drive nearing the sixteenth marker and edged ahead through the waning yards. BULL FLYS blocked just behind the early speed, gained a clear path four wide at the head of the lane, gained a narrow lead inside the furlong marker but could not hold back GONE PACK N late. DOME ALASKA soon gained the lead after the start, lost the advantage after travelling a furlong, came again along the rail in the stretch but did not have enough left the final sixteenth. ICE BOY without early foot between horses, was three and four wide taking the bend and steadily closed the gap through the lane. KINGS LEGACY showed first, backed up between rivals going to the turn, swung out six wide into the stretch, improved position some upper stretch and finished evenly. ANCIENT APPEAL broke through the gate before the break, was reloaded then appeared to bobble a bit when the race began, took the lead after a furlong, set a pressured pace between rivals, two wide through the turn, challenged from both sides in the lane and wore down the last furlong. TRICK RYDER contested the pace from outside on the backstretch, four and five wide taking the bend then weakened for the drive. DART GUN was an early contender between horses, failed to keep up just off the inside on the turn and continued to flatten through the stretch. TRADERS TURN void of speed between horses, was three wide on the turn, swung to the outside for the

stretch run and lacked a significant bid. QUITE A LINE displayed early speed between rivals but faded three wide leaving the bend. DUDE ON THE LOOSE was soon well back, moved to the outside on the turn and came up empty for the drive. JEWELL'S KING trailed well off the inside, fell after travelling two furlongs and was vanned off. There was a stewards' inquiry into the fall JEWELL'S KING took on the backstretch but no action taken after their review.
