BUCKSTER broke sharply then settled down the backstretch, placed a bid three wide nearing the quarter pole, was urged steadily and inched away in the final yards. GINGER'S SON moved up between rivals to press the early pace, vied at the top of the stretch, drew clear at the eighth pole, was challenged in the final yards and outfinished. GO BARNEY GO was within striking distance early racing six wide, angled in to save some ground, went four wide in the stretch and lacked a gain. ADMIRAL'S CROWN was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and placed a mild effort late. LIVE AMMO set a pressured early pace saving ground, drifted out nearing the eighth pole then gave way. BAD BOY BULL was forwardly placed early five wide then faded. CHARMING JIG saved ground to no avail.
