SOCKO rated two wide between CONTINUUM and MR. DECATUR, then battled through midstretch before shaking free nearing the sixteenth marker and prevailed. TOP HIT got boxed in early and stayed that way until inside the sixteenth marker when it was too late but gained the place at the wire. MR. DECATUR pressed the issue while in hand three wide and battled into deep stretch but weakened a bit late. RAYO DE PLATA was bumped early on, settled into position off the rail, bid four wide to challenge midway on the far turn but came up flat for the drive. CONTINUUM rated near the rail but weakened through the stretch and had no visible excuse. AIRIASAFFAIR had brief inside speed but little to say afterwards.
