MAJOR BILLLY settled into stride six wide, moved up down the backstretch, contested the pacesetter nearing the quarter pole, dueled into deep stretch, dug in the final strides and edged clear. EARLY RUMOR pressed the early pace, gained a short lead nearing the quarter pole, was challenged thru the stretch, dueled to the sixteenth pole with a game try but was outfinished. FLYER BE QUICK was forwardly placed between foes, then steadied into the turn, altered outward five wide and finished willingly to gain the show. AX ME NICE was within striking distance early between foes, rallied into the stretch racing just off the rail then flattened in the drive. JUNEBUG was off slow early, went five wide at the quarter pole and placed a mild bid. THE GREAT STRAUSS was unhurried early, raced six wide and lacked a gain late. RAIL RIDER was within striking distance early, placed a brief bid then yielded. CARRY THE LOAD was outrun early and passed tiring foes in the stretch. COMANCHE MAN pressed the early pace and was finished after a half. BEACH HOUSE LUIS showed some brief speed along the inside and yielded in the lane. SIR SQUIDWARD raced wide and was not a factor. BIN DERE trailed the field racing well off the rail and was always outrun.
