OILFIELD TRASH rushed to assume early command from a three wide stance, cleared all rivals entering the turn and angled inward to the two path, maintained that line into the homestretch and held off rivals for the score. RICHARD PRICHARD led second flight through the bend, tucked inward at top of stretch but couldn't catch the leader in final furlong. AWESOME CITY pressed the pace as the outer most of three rivals through the turn then finished under constant urging while unable to match strides with top pair. J C AVENUE saved ground to no avail. CALL ME ZEASY steadily improved position after showing reserve early. PROSPECT'S LEGACY settled into a chasing pose and failed to threaten. COCKTAIL BAY trekked the three path and passed tiring foes in late going. BREAK DANCE rated mid pack and along the inside before tiring in crucial stages. SAID SO travelled wide down the backstretch and through the turn before being eased in stretch.
