OMER'S SURE SHOT moved up between horses on the backstretch to share the lead, two wide on the second turn, drifted out as he moved ahead upper stretch, under a steady drive the last eighth and held sway. INIQUITOUS KID was boxed in behind the early speed, angled out three wide on the second turn, gradually altered out upper stretch as he bid outside OMER'S SURE SHOT, slowly closed in, was too late but easily second best. TORO LOCO broke outward, bumped BIG LADY RUN, was rated in midpack just off the inside, bid along the rail on the second bend, fanned out to path three into the lane, lacked a rally but pulled clear for third in deep stretch. PLAYNATHEFUNERAL settled, was just off the inside through the early going, altered out five wide upper stretch and passed tired ones. DONEDIGGIN broke alertly, soon had the inside, was challenged on the backstretch then wore down along the rail in the stretch. BIRDIE GULCH was forwardly placed just outside the pacesetters, failed to keep up on the second turn, came four wide into the lane and weakened. BIG LADY RUN bumped at the start, was steadied briefly, void of speed, commenced a mild bid from inside on the second turn, advanced to midstretch then leveled off. MUNDO FLASH came out a bit slowly and throwing his head, was taken inside early on, saved ground the rest of the way and was never a factor. GILDED MOVES raced in midpack from outside, began to fade while three then four wide wide through the second turn, altered out to stay clear of PLAYNATHEFUNERAL upper stretch and continued to fade. PRINCE LONGFELLOW soon backed up from between horses, moved to the outside once on the backstretch and showed little.
