Footnotes

JACKPOT WHO was allowed to settle early, closed the gap racing four wide, gained command into the stretch and held a safe advantage to the wire. KEY TO THE BAND was off slow early, gained ground in the turn, swung out five wide and finished well to get up for the place. JONES was within striking distance early, vied nearing the quarter pole, battled for the place into deep stretch and was outfinished for that position. DESERT GAMBLE was off slow early, rallied nearing the quarter pole four wide, altered inward at the sixteenth to contend briefly then flattened out. TUFF REVIEW was unhurried early, went six wide late and lacked a late response. TONY THE CAT showed some brief speed then faded in the stretch. PATRICK YULLA forced the early pace between rivals then tired and gave way. HASTY MAIDEN raced well off the rail and improved her position in the stretch. TWIST N SPIN showed little and was outrun. AINT HE A SCOOTER moved up to prompt the early pace and was finished early.
