SILK STRAWBERRY was within striking distance early along the inside, made a bold move to come through at the quarter pole, drew clear into the stretch and widened. RIO FRESCO set the early pace racing off the inside, was challenged near the quarter pole and failed to match strides. MOONFACE prompted the early pace four wide, lacked a closing rally but held the show. SUPER STORMY was forwardly placed three wide and lacked a late effort. ROAD TIME was off slow early saving ground, placed a brief bid then flattened. KISSSTIN was unhurried early, went seven wide near the three sixteenth and failed to menace. MISS DESERT FREEZE was void of early speed while saving ground, swung out six wide into the stretch and was not a threat. NEW GOLD retreated steadily and was not a factor.
