BROTHER LOUIE was never far back early racing off the inside, began to rally angling five wide into the stretch and kicked clear in the final furlong. MAX BEAN was within striking distance early, went four wide to place a bid, battled from between rivals into the stretch but was outfinished in the late going. ROSA'S CATENA showed early speed then settled down the backstretch, angled out to come back in the second turn then weakened in the drive. BROTHER JOHN D. was unhurried early, drifted out seven wide into the stretch and showed some interest late. RUNNING SQUALL was off slow early, was widest into the stretch and showed some effort late. DOMS THUNDER raced mid pack off the inside, made a move mid way then yielded. SPRING TO TERAS was forwardly placed early, went five wide near the quarter pole then gave way. SAPELLO CANTADOR showed little in a dull effort. DESERT GAMBLE was outrun early racing off the inside then faded steadily. DESERT TAP showed early speed, gained a short lead into the second turn, was used up early and stopped in the stretch.
