Footnotes

AWESOME DUDETTE bumped with CONSERVATIVE QUEEN then ELEVENTH HOUR at the start, stayed close between horses, advanced three wide on the turn, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, was all out and got up in time. RESTLESS MISSILE broke on top, showed the way just off the inside, moved clear leaving the turn, floated out some near the eighth pole, was corrected, tried hard but was outfinished in a game effort. ELEVENTH HOUR bumped just after the break, found herself boxed in on the backstretch, gradually moved to the rail on the turn, floated out some into the stretch, closed the gap upper stretch, leveled off in the late going but was clearly best of the rest. CONSERVATIVE QUEEN bumped with AWESOME DUDETTE at the start, was a contender toward the outside, four and five wide taking the turn, altered out to stay clear of FIRM GOLD upper stretch and made up some ground the last eighth. FIRM GOLD pressed the early speed from outside, in path three on the turn, began to back up in tight quarters between rivals leaving the bend, was steadied in traffic at the top of the lane, altered out for a clear path upper stretch and continued to fade. MEDAL WINNER soon trailed just off the inside, swung out leaving the turn, came into the stretch from path five and had no rally. D' ELEGANCE was a factor from outside, lost ground widest through the bend and empty for the drive. HUBCITY LADY prominent from inside, began to back up some into the turn, was steadied briefly when her path was taken just past the three-furlong marker, continued to stay inside and steadily gave way.
