ARROWCOCITY was within striking distance early, went four wide to place a bid near the five sixteenth, placed a steady effort to gain the lead and held gamely. AUGHT EIGHT chased the early leaders from the outside, vied to be on even terms in the second turn, lost ground into the stretch then battled back late and missed in the late going. A GHOST BY CHOICE showed some early speed drawing clear, was challenged down the backstretch, lost the advantage into the stretch, fought hard then gave way grudgingly. GLENWOOD AUGGIE was outrun early, sustained a steady effort racing five wide. PAL O DOME was void of early speed saving ground, angled out five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. CALL IT A NIGHT prompted the early pace racing off the inside then faded steadily. STORMING SPIRIT was unhurried early, sustained a bid into the second turn, went wrong near the quarter pole, was taken up and vanned off.
