**Footnotes**

MCKENNA BOY stalked from outside, made his bid four wide on the turn, got the advantage upper stretch then gradually edged ahead under steady urging. DEVONAS REALITY was quickly clear, showed the way from inside, challenged into the lane, fought gamely, did not have enough left but was clearly second best. LANE STORMER without early foot, picked up his pace just off the rail on the turn, altered out to path six nearing the eighth pole, steadily closed the gap and got up for third near the wire. YEE HAW was hustled along from inside, angled out to path four midstretch then failed to make up much ground the final furlong. EXPECT A GENIUS was prominent just outside DEVONAS REALITY to midstretch then began to wear down. ZEBBA in midpack early just off the inside, angled out some on the turn, came four wide into the lane, altered in approaching the furlong marker and failed to have a late bid. SHUG'S STORM CAT raced in the second flight between horses, three and four wide taking the bend and flattened for the drive. JUST JIMMY J hesitated at the start, angled in nearing the turn, fanned out six wide for the stretch run, progressed to the eighth pole then leveled off. CHENAUULT'S DEPUTY was soon well back, angled in on the turn then could only pass a few tired ones in the lane. YONDERLY also hesitated at the break then showed little in a wide trip. LANE'S VALUE displayed early speed between rivals but faded from path three leaving the bend. FULL OF NAEVUS stayed well off the inside throughout and steadily gave way.
