Footnotes

SMOKIN' LEGEND settled off the inside, commenced his bid just off the rail on the turn, swung out six wide into the lane, rallied, was steadied briefly when brushed by TRIMIT inside the eighth pole then shook off NOW AND ZEN under a drive in the waning yards. NOW AND ZEN contested the pace between horses, floated out to path three into the lane, slowly drifted out going to the eighth pole, bumped with TRIMIT at that marker, was corrected, continued to battle for the advantage but did not have enough left. TRIMIT steadily improved position outside to vie for the lead five wide upper stretch, was squeezed just inside the eighth pole, checked and did not regain best stride. BRONZE FOX was prominent just off the inside to the final furlong then began to tire. TEXAS BREWED raced with BRONZE FOX from just outside to the eighth pole then also began to fade. ALL MAXED OUT pressed from outside, took the bend four wide then flattened out. GILDED PROMISE ran in contention from inside but came up empty leaving the turn. IRISH TRYST dueled for the lead inside to the top of the lane then gave way. VALLEY TRYST displayed early speed between horses but quit four wide on the turn and was allowed to coast through the lane. The rider of TRIMIT lodged an objection alleging interference from SMOKIN' LEGEND and NOW AND ZEN midstretch. After their review, the stewards made no change.
