SUMMER SURVIVOR forced the early pace, edged clear down the backstretch, was challenged into the second turn, dueled into the stretch, dug in the final strides and drew clear. REGAL CAREER was well placed early, moved up along the inside to sustain a bid, then dueled into the stretch, battled gamely but didn't have enough late. STORMIN STORY was close in the early going racing five wide, vied down the back stretch, showed some interest late and gained the show. SPARK OF DUBAI chased the early leaders four wide and lacked a late effort. STORMING SEA was unhurried early and showed some interest late along the inside. YES HE'S A PISTOL was off slow early and lacked a gain late six wide. DIAMOND HONDO was void of early speed racing wide and passed tiring foes late. SUREFIRE SUCCESS showed some early speed along the inside, then faded while drifting out. PAY THE VIG failed to sustain a bid. ANYBODYS GUESS dropped back early and was not a factor. SEA BATTLE raced mid pack while saving ground then retreated.
