MISCHIEF LANE chased the early leader racing off the rail, angled four wide to place a bid at the five sixteenth, shifted in some nearing the three sixteenth then gained the lead and drew clear. KING OF THE DANCE was allowed to settle early, rallied five wide in the stretch, closed with urging and gained the

place. EROS EISHIN was forwardly placed early along the rail, vied into the stretch, drifted out into the stretch forcing ROCKIN AVENUE to steady then weakened in the drive. CHARLIE'S EGO was outrun early, angled out four wide and showed some effort late. ETERNAL WARRIOR was off slow early, fanned eight wide into the stretch and sustained a mild gain late. CARSON PRINCE raced mid pack and lacked a closing response. ROCKIN AVENUE was unhurried early, went four wide near the quarter pole, altered inward to make a move then was pinched back and forced to steady near the three sixteenth and failed to recover. GOLDEN EXCUSE was forwardly placed early racing off the inside then tired. CELESTIAL SPIRIT saved ground to no avail. KID CRAWFORD drew quickly clear along the inside, drifted out some near the three sixteenth, was bumped then faded in the lane. JIM WADE raced wide and was not a factor. M P STORM MANIA raced wide trailing the field and was not a threat. There was a Stewards Inquiry, also the rider of KID CRAWFORD claimed interference against the rider of MISCHIEF LANE, after reviewing the films it was determined that MISCHIEF LANE and EROS EISHIN would be disqualified for interference entering the stretch. PER RULING DATED 4/19/12 RECIEVED FROM THE NEW MEXICO RACING COMMISSION (RULING #2934812) MISCHIEF LANE HAS BEEN RETRUNED TO FIRST PLACE.
