MESA CAY was close in the early going racing off the rail, angled three wide down the backstretch, sustained a bid to gain a clear advantage at the eighth pole then opened up late. COOKIE RULES was off slow early, went four wide, loomed up into the second turn, was within striking into the stretch but was no match for the winner. SHOOTITALL unseated his rider in the post parade, then stalked the early leaders racing off the inside, rallied between rivals in the second turn, gained a short advantage at the quarter pole then flattened in the drive. UNBRIDAL'SVOW was outrun early, went three wide and placed a mild effort in the stretch. BEAU'S HALO was allowed to settle early racing off the rail and lacked a bid late. JERRY LEE WHO was slow early saving ground and lacked a closing response. JAC CADILLAC raced mid pack off the rail and weakened. T DRIVE set the early pace, opened up down the backstretch, was used up early and stopped.
