Footnotes

ROSE IS A RAGE soon had the lead between horses, stayed off the inside taking the bend, drifted out after entering the last furlong, kept a straight path the final sixteenth and held sway. MARTINI WAGER was prominent outside from the beginning, moved clear for second leaving the turn, forced out to stay clear of ROSE IS A RAGE inside the final furlong, hung in the waning yards but was easily second best. TRILLUA pressed from between horses, began to back up some on the turn, took the rail into the lane and could only just hold third in deep stretch. AFTER CURFEW was an early contender just off the inside, did not stay close on the turn, fanned out to path six for the stretch run, lugged in late and narrowly missed third. ST WAGER blocked behind a wall of horses on the backstretch, gained the rail into the bend, swung out five wide entering the lane, progressed to midstretch and was forced in late. SANET was an early factor toward the outside, four to six wide through the turn, angled inside AFTER CURFEW nearing the eighth pole then altered in to avoid the latter inside the final sixteenth. THANKSFORTHERIDE also blocked behind the early speed on the backstretch, faded just off the rail on the turn, swung out five wide into the stretch, angled out further for a clear path inside the eighth pole and lacked a significant response. BOSQUE BARBIE soon trailed just off the inside, fanned to path eight for the drive and gradually improved position without threatening. TEXAS COWGIRL pressed from inside but faded along the rail leaving the turn. MUSIC GOES ROUND was never a factor in a wide trip. LADY ACCORD displayed brief speed then gave way three wide on the bend. MIKAY AS LADY broke awkwardly, advanced between horses, four wide on the turn, fanned out further entering the stretch, was steadied briefly when her path was compromised at the head of the lane, altered in then proved unresponsive under stern urging.
