Footnotes

SHIGEIO vied for the early lead from outside, moved clear two wide leaving the bend, floated out some entering the lane, continued to lengthen command and proved best ridden out. TETON CLASS stumbled at the break, quickly recovered to race closest to the early speed, had the rail on the turn, floated out behind SHIGEIO into the lane, altered in some upper stretch, took over second and could only hold his position late. BIG DADDY NORMAN came off the rail some midway on the backstretch, moved back inside on the bend, also fanned out to path three for the drive, altered out some upper stretch, gained third, could no close the gap on the top pair the last eighth but proved easily best of the rest. YADACAT gradually backed up from inside, swung out on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, was checked behind CLAUDE H shortly after that, altered out and improved his position without threatening. CLAUDE H was steadied behind DELTA RUSH after travelling the first sixteenth, also in paths three then four taking the bend, altered out quickly when BIG DADDY NORMAN came out upper stretch and lugged in a couple times as he faded. CAT'S BOY BURN showed first, slowly retreated though hustled along from outside, drifted out some taking the turn, came into the stretch widest of all and had no late bid. DELTA RUSH steadily angled in as he contested the early pace, could not stay with SHIGEIO leaving the turn and flattened out for the drive.
