Footnotes

SPECIAL AGENT SLEW settled early, advanced from outside on the backstretch to vie for the lead into the second bend, angled in some to be two wide entering the lane, battled through the stretch and edged ahead in the waning yards. SHAZBOT contested the pace from path three, gained the advantage between horses into the second turn, soon gained the rail, fought gamely in the stretch, did not have enough late but was easily second best. HEZA RARE BULL boxed in behind the early speed, got through four wide near the half mile pole, progressed three wide on the second turn to take over third, angled in some leaving that bend, drifted out upper stretch, lugged in some near the sixteenth marker and could only hold his position. GLENWOOD AUGGIE in the second flight just off the inside, was blocked nearing the second turn, split horses into that bend, moved to the rail, failed to keep up, fanned out to path three entering the lane, altered out as HEZA RARE BULL came out upper stretch and had no late rally. SLICKUNO a bit slow at the break, advanced along the rail, was checked briefly behind the fading JUSTA SLUMDOG early in the second turn, altered out some, steadily backed up, was eased in distress deep stretch and vanned off. JUSTA SLUMDOG soon had a slight advantage, set a pressured pace from paths two or three, shifted in entering the second turn and quickly gave way.
