SPEEDY FALCON stalked SPOILED and SANDIA'S FLICKA into the far turn, moved to challenge that pair three wide midway on that bend, quickly took over and held sway through the stretch while under a steady drive. SPOILED took the rail into the turn but proved no match for the winner, then steadied and angled out three wide and made a minor late gain. ONA RAMPAGE took the turn two wide and angled out a bit for clear sailing into the stretch in order to pick up the show. PAPPARRATZI broke well but suddenly ducked to the outside, then angled to the rail, saved ground on the turn and improved position. WISH FOR GOLD took back and angled inside after the break, advanced from near the rail on the turn, swung out nearing the stretch and was within reach but offered no rally. SANDIA'S FLICKA was outbroke, quickly rushed up to vie for the lead two wide between horses but came up empty in the drive. ROCKIN ON was through early after chasing the leaders three wide. SO SILENT retreated on the turn. The jockey of SPOILED lodged an objection against SPEEDY FALCON, alleging interference at the five-sixteenths pole but the claim was dismissed by the stewards in short order.
