**Footnotes**

SLEWRUN set the early pace, held the advantage into deep stretch, fought hard in the final yards and proved best late. AUDIENCE was unhurried early, vied three wide, found his best stride late and missed. POINT OF IMPACT stalked the early leaders three or four wide, sustained a bid into the stretch then flattened in deep stretch but held the show. RYAN'S GOLD was outrun early, rallied five wide nearing the quarter pole and was gaining late. SINCY'S WONDER was off slow early, went six wide at the quarter pole and showed some interest late in the stretch. MY PIZAZZ dropped back early racing off the rail and placed a mild effort late. NATIVITY PREP broke sharply, was close in the early going between rivals then weakened. ROYAL THRILL broke well behind the field and passed tiring foes. VERIFY pressed the early pace between foes, was used up and gave way. SUMMER SNOW forced the early pace three wide, was hard used then retreated.
