Footnotes

TRISTANS SLEW settled well of the inside, gradually advanced between horses, was three then four wide taking the second turn, all out between rivals in the stretch and got up in time. INIQUITOUS KID jostled briefly with YVETT'S MAAR just after the start, advanced from outside to vie for the lead from path three midway on the second turn, rallied deep stretch, had a slight advantage nearing the wire but was outfinished in a game effort. AMOROSO progressed between horses on the backstretch, was caught in tight quarters nearing the second turn, angled in some as he went for the lead into that bend, moved clear leaving the turn, floated out some upper stretch and did not have enough left inside the final sixteenth. SUPER SAPELLO rated between rivals, swung out on the second turn, came six wide into the lane, closed well but too late. EL LOCK O' without early speed, was four wide on the second bend, angled in

some for the stretch run, closed the gap upper stretch then leveled off. K O JUSTICE prominent between horses, was caught in tight quarters nearing the second turn, checked three wide into the bend, faded, fanned out some for the stretch run and passed tired ones five wide. JADED DREAMS broke alertly, set or forced the pace from inside but gave way on the second turn. NEW MEXICO KID void of speed, began to advance along the rail on the second bend, altered out some for a clear path inside the final furlong but lacked a significant response. LANE STORMER broke outward, jostled briefly with YVETT'S MAAR, advanced from outside to have a striking position four then five wide through the second turn, gave way upper stretch, was steadied and allowed to float out. YVETT'S MAAR jostled between horses just after the break, raced in midpack to the second turn then gave way. OMER'S SURE SHOT displayed early speed between rivals but quit two wide on the second turn. TINZAR steadily faded from inside, floated out some into the lane and continued to give way.
