GO EMMIT GO rated from inside, angled out on the bend, came five wide into the stretch then steadily drew off under a mild drive. ELWAY set a pressured pace between horses, had the rail on the bend, was no match for the winner in the lane, all out and held second. TO TERATAKI forwardly placed between rivals, was four to six wide through the turn, took over third upper stretch, was getting to ELWAY in the late going and easily best of the rest. HEZA ALLIGATOR trailed, progressed along the inside to midstretch then leveled off. MURDEROUS in contention early, failed to keep up four wide through the turn, fanned out behind TO TERATAKI entering the lane, altered out widest upper stretch and passed tired ones. QUINSTARGOLD broke outward, disputed the pace between horses, two wide taking the bend and flattened out for the drive. GOLDEN M P was a factor just off the inside behind the early speed but gave way on the turn. PRAYTIME crowded briefly at the break, pressed from outside, was three wide through the turn then tired in the lane.
