CLAY COURT rated on the outside of pacesetters through the opening turn and travelled four wide down the backstretch then trekked three wide through far turn and wore down the leader inside the three sixteenths pole for the score. RISING GIANT advanced with a mid move from four wide, rated close up at top of stretch but was unable to match strides with eventual winner in final furlong. PANCHO WHO settled between rivals, improved position nearing the half pole, and rallied mildly to earn the show but was too little too late for the score. QUINTON'S WHO rushed from outset to early command, led the field into homestretch but had no late offering to sustain the bid. MANCATION tucked to save ground and lacked a late rally to improve placing. EL MAXIMO passed tiring foes after trailing the field early. BEAUMONT TIME steadily faded from a two path stance. PARKS N RECREATION broke alertly and rated close up for the opening half before retreating rapidly in latter half of contest.
