Footnotes

GUILTYBYASSOCIATION gradually progressed between horses, was three wide on the turn, all out in the stretch, gradually forced out inside the final furlong but got up in time. RAISE THE BRIDLE was quickly clear, showed the way just off the inside, roused into the stretch, slowly drifted out under a left-hand whip inside the last eighth and was narrowly outfinished in a game effort. LOUZADO somewhat awkward from the gate, bumped with JAC CADILLAC, moved up from between horses, gained the rail into the bend, angled out nearing the quarter pole, came four wide into the lane, lugged in going to the furlong maker, was altered out, drifted out further, kept a straight path the final sixteenth and was closing in on the top pair. MAGNANIMITY well placed from inside, came off the rail some for a clear path entering the lane and failed to have a stretch bid. CALI TA without speed between horses, advanced just off the rail on the turn, gradually altered out from behind MAGNANIMITY upper stretch and made up minor ground late. HANDSOME MON was soon well behind, angled in nearing the half mile marker, progressed along the rail on the turn, slowly altered out to stay clear of CALI TA upper stretch and gradually made up ground the final eighth. MR. TRAV pressed the early speed from outside, angled in on the bend then flattened for the drive. CALL IN bumped several times with MISTER HOOT just after the break, was steadied behind traffic shortly after entering the main track, was soon well back, not far off the inside taking the turn and lacked a stretch bid. JAC CADILLAC bumped with LOUZADO at the start, raced in contention from outside but gave way four wide on the turn. MISTER HOOT quickly overcame several bumps with CALI IN after the start, pressed the pace from between horses but faded three wide, angled out widest into the stretch and continued to give way.
