Footnotes

ROCK BOX blocked behind the early speed going to the turn, got through from path four early in the bend, gradually lugged in as she dueled for the lead through the stretch and edged ahead in the waning yards. ISTINT MAGIC disputed the pace outside from the early going, in path three through the turn, also slowly lugged in fighting for the lead in the lane, did not have enough late but was easily second best. SAFEWAY DAN prominent just off the inside on the backstretch, failed to keep up along the rail on the turn, angled out some for a clear path just inside the eighth pole and again deep stretch and caught JULIEANNA B for third. JULIEANNA B was sent to set a pressured pace between horses, just off the inside taking the bend then slowly wore down the final furlong. DESERT BLUSH dwelt at the start, was hustled along and soon brought inside, swung out some into the stretch, angled to path five going to the eighth pole and passed tired ones. MISS BAMA BREEZE was an early contender from inside, failed to keep up along the rail on the turn, regained a striking position upper stretch but leveled off instead. ROSE FROST was gradually angled out on the backstretch, in path three taking the bend, lacked the needed stretch bid and was angled outside SAFEWAY DAN late. SOARING BEEGEE in hand behind traffic shortly after the break, was soon taken outside, lost ground five wide through the turn and faded widest for the drive.
