Footnotes

YOUR MY IRISH PAL pinched between rivals at the break, pressed from outside, improved position three wide on the turn, was all out in the lane and began to edged ahead in the waning yards. COUNTRYBUMPKIN WHO bumped with YOUR MY IRISH PAL at the start, was prominent between horses, angled in two wide on the bend, had the lead into the lane, battled gamely through the stretch but had to settle for second best. SOME FUN without early foot between horses, steadily advanced, was four wide on the turn, all out in the stretch, was too late but clearly best of the rest. DIXIE FILM prominent between rivals, was blocked just off the rail on the turn and gradually faded the last eighth. BOLIVAR SHAG forwardly placed between horses, found himself boxed in along the rail leaving the turn, was steadied then checked hard at the top of the stretch, altered out when clear with a furlong left but had no late bid. MR JUAN forced in at the break, was soon at the back, lost ground staying in path four on the turn, swung out some into the lane, angled out widest upper stretch and steadily improved position. TRICKY WARRIOR was away slowly then had to alter in, was also at the back of the pack early, saved ground through the turn and passed tired ones in the stretch. BARGAIN TABLE away a bit slow, clipped U GOT MONEY HONEY'S heels soon after the break, progressed from outside, was five or six wide taking the bend and leveled off the last eighth. ANCIENT OF DAYS broke inward, was in midpack early but faded just off the inside on the turn. REECE N OLIVIA broke in stride, set the pace from inside but gave way the last quarter mile. U GOT MONEY HONEY also bumped with YOUR MY IRISH PAL at the start, showed no speed between horses, in path three leaving the turn and was empty for the drive. ROLLIN ON CHROME broke inward, was soon blocked, moved inside and was an early factor, swung out for room on the turn, failed to keep up, was five wide

entering the stretch and continued to fade between horses.
