Footnotes

BIG JOHN BEAN stalked POPZ from just outside, was asked leaving the second turn, quickly moved clear, angled in entering the stretch then maintained control under steady handling. POPZ soon had the lead, showed the way just off the inside, was roused when challenged on the second turn, could not stay with BIG JOHN BEAN, angled outside the latter into the lane, proved no match but was clearly second best. TUFF REVIEW gradually advanced between horses, was three wide on the second bend, dueled for third in the lane and shook off GHOSTLY FLY late. GHOSTLY FLY advanced from outside on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, battled for third from along rail in the stretch but weakened in the waning yards. TORO LOCO was checked in tight quarters into the first turn, gradually angled outside on the backstretch, was widest taking the second turn, in path seven entering the lane, drifted out some upper stretch, progressed to the last furlong then could only move clear for his position. SILVA TUNG DEVIL was a forward factor in hand toward the outside the first half then faded three wide on the second bend, lugged in deep stretch and was steadied. KEY TO THE BAND was a brief contender between horses, could not stay close just off the inside on the second turn, had little left in the lane, was crowded nearing the wire and steadied. A TREASURED QUOTE void of speed from outside, angled in some entering the second turn, swung out to path six for the drive and was empty. WILDINTHEWILDWEST hesitated at the start, rushed up to contention from inside but faded along the rail leaving the second turn. GO GET IT BARBITO was angled in on the backstretch, saved ground through the second turn, unresponsive in the stretch, lost contact with the field, finished the course and walked off.
