MAX BEAN settled back from traffic into the first bend, was boxed in behind the early speed, altered out six wide midway on the second turn, angled in some as he took the lead nearing the three-sixteenths marker, quickly moved clear and was kept to task to the wire. SUPER SAPELLO shared the lead between rivals from the beginning, three wide on the second turn, floated out some as he lost the advantage leaving that bend, moved outside MAX BEAN at the head of the lane, drifted out some approaching the eighth pole, was all out the final furlong but could only hold his position. CAPTAIN COOPER settled not far off the inside, commenced his bid after a half mile, swung out widest with a quarter mile to go, lost ground fanning to path eight entering the lane, gained third midstretch and pulled clear for the show late. DIXIE FILM caught six wide into the first bend, improved position from outside on the backstretch, went for the lead five wide on the second turn, was forced out to path seven into the stretch, began to wear down, altered inside SUPER SAPELLO just inside the final eighth and lugged in late. OUTOFECHO in contention toward the outside, was four then five wide through the second turn, could only pass some tired ones in the lane and was angled in as DIXIE FILM came in deep stretch. ROYAL JESTER contested the pace two wide for

nearly six furlongs but did not have enough left for the drive. HIGH RIDGE RUNNER soon trailed from inside, came off the rail some just before entering the second turn, moved to a striking position leaving that bend, fanned three wide for the stretch run and flattened. COW PUNCHIN CASEY also blocked behind the early speed, began to fade three wide on the second turn, floated out to path six entering the stretch and had little left. O K'S BLUFF vied for the lead five then four wide for six furlongs then gave way. CHROME BOY displayed early speed inside but began to tire before finishing six furlongs.
