UH OH TRAFFIC in midpack early, bid four wide on the turn, had the lead leaving the bend, moved clear upper stretch and held off SOPHISTICATED under steady handling. SOPHISTICATED taken back just after the break, progressed between horses, swung out leaving the turn, came widest into the lane, was all out, lugged in late, came up short but was easily second best. STEPPIN rated off the early speed, also made her move for the lead, while between rivals, on the turn, could not stay with UH OH TRAFFIC upper stretch, moved to the inside soon after and leveled off. KATIE'S COUSIN advanced along the inside on the turn, altered out for a clear path upper stretch, drifted out further near the eighth pole and improved her position some inside the last eighth without threatening. ALEXANDRATHEGREAT also in midpack early, failed to keep up just off the inside on the turn, drifted out midstretch and finished evenly. CLEAR CREEK CANYON sprinted away from the rest, showed the way just off the inside, was challenged on the bend and tired for the drive. CASEY'S RAINBOW showed first but soon trailed from outside, stayed well off the inside throughout and showed little. DE LAREDO ROSE was never a factor in a ground-saving trip.
