Footnotes

RALLELUJAH was never far back early, circled the field five wide, closed well drifting in some through the stretch and edged clear. CALL ME LOUIE was well back early, sustained a steady effort, went seven wide into the stretch and was gaining late. DELAYED BY WHO was unhurried early, went four wide between foes in the stretch, finished well and just missed the place. FIRE LIKE ANOUTLAW was hustled early to force the pace racing off the inside then flattened late. SIR CARMEN was within striking distance early, went four wide to place a bid, gained a short lead then faltered in the drive. SHINING SOURCE was off slow early then showed some interest late. SHEET SECRETS was outrun early saving ground, placed a brief bid then weakened. TAIL TO THE BOMB raced mid pack, went six wide near the three sixteenths and lacked a late response. SALLYsquall dropped back, went six wide and was not a factor. MISSING WHO showed early speed three wide and was finished early. IM JOE KOOL was forwardly placed early four wide then retreated.
