TOP DANCER pressed the early pace from along the inside, inched away nearing the wire and was best late. DIXIELAND CHIME set a pressured early pace from the outside, dueled with TOP DANCER into the stretch and failed to match strides with the winner. UNCLE JACK G forced the early pace five wide, lacked a gain late but held the show. CHROME BOY was void of early speed, rallied at the top of the stretch and closed fast between foes late. PAULS HEART was within striking three wide, was between foes at the quarter pole, angled out near the three sixteenth and went evenly. COPELAN'S ACE was unhurried early, made a move mid way then weakened. TRISTANS SLEW was outrun early, was wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. TRICKY RAIDER raced mid pack, went seven wide in the stretch and lacked a late effort. GO DAD GO was well back early saving ground and failed to threaten.

MAGICAL PROGRAM showed little and was outrun. HATTIE'S MEMORY was close in the early going then retreated steadily.
