TEJANO CAT drew quickly clear into the first turn, was challenged into the second turn, lost the advantage at the top of the stretch, responded to the challenge and kicked clear in mid stretch to prove best. WHOS LAZY chased the early leaders along the inside, was a bit hard to settle in the first turn, rallied three wide at the three sixteenth and gained the place. JOLI'S DOME was outrun early, was the widest down the backstretch, then showed some effort late and got up for the show. DIAMONDS FOR V F prompted the early pace from between rivals, made a bid to edge clear at the quarter pole then came up empty in the stretch. LEADING A STORM was within striking distance early and lacked a rally late. OUTTA HAND was unhurried early racing off the rail and lacked a late response. DESERT BRIAN was outrun early seven wide down the backstretch, angled in some near the quarter, went five wide late and failed to threaten. ANOTHERCHO raced mid pack then retreated steadily. CONCERNING CHIMES trailed the field and was not a factor.
